A discussion session and a doa mahfil were organized for the salvation of the departed souls of the Father of the nation Bangabandhu

Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, members of his family and others who were brutally murdered on this day in 1975. The welfare of the nation and country was also prayed for in the mahfil.

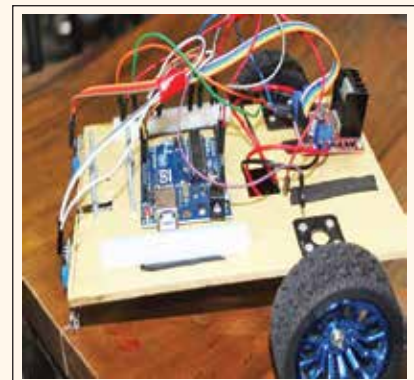

Study Tour to Karnafuli Hydroelectric Power Station by the Students of EEE Department: The Department of EEE of Prime University always strives to provide industrial-oriented experience along with classroom teaching to its students. As part of this effort, on August 25, 2022, 27 students of 49th and 52nd batch of EEE department visited the “Karnafuli Hydroelectric Power Station” located at Kaptai, Rangamati. Two faculty members of the EEE department, Md. Abdul Halim, Senior Lecturer, Sunirmal Kumar Biswas, Senior Lecturer accompanied them for necessary support and inspiration .

This plant was constructed in 1962 as part of the “Karnafuli Multipurpose Project”, and is one of the biggest water resources development projects of Bangladesh. The generation capacity of this power plant is 230 MW. The students visited the earth filled dam of the power plant and collected information of different electrical components of the plants and had knowledge about the working procedure of different sub-system. The department will take initiatives to continue such industrial tours.

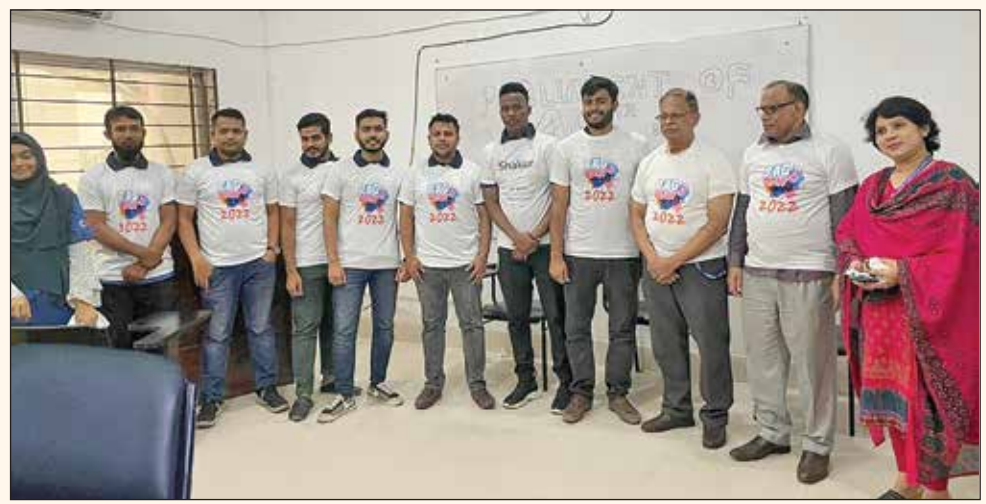
